- 1. The Annual Report (2019-20) of the IQAC is read and confirmed with a few minor corrections and requested the chairman to submit the report within the due date
- 2. Students Satisfaction Survey report was placed in the meeting. The coordinator reported that 233 existing and passed out students participated in the survey. They give their valuable assessment regarding the teaching learning quality, syllabus content, teachers' efficiency, institutional infrastructure, evaluation and fairness etc. All the cases the assessment scores more than 60 percent. The IQAC expressed satisfaction on the overall performance of the institution. However, the IQAC requested the faculties to involve more students in the process of SSS. And after a careful consideration the whole report following suggestions made by the students were taken for implementation:
 - 2.1 To increase the number of ICT enabled class room;
 - 2.2 Emphasis was laid on the assignments based on applied aspects of the discipline;
 - 2.3 Number of online classes to be increased for timely completion of the syllabus;
 - 2.4 Emphasis was given to create new vacancy for the appointment of full time faculty specially in the single faculty discipline;

- 2.5 Number of Text and reference books in the library to be increased with respect to the newly introduced CBCS syllabus;
- 2.6 Chemistry, Botany and Zoology lab to be renovated with latest technologies and more specimens and reagents for extensive practical classes;
- 2.7 Emphasis was given on more students centric teaching;

The principal is requested to move the suggestion to the apex administrative body of the college to take necessary action for implementation in Kaliachak College.
